The job is physically challenging, standing all weather conditions, and within specific time frames for most customers, whether at businesses or households. Being extremely important standing pressure for a fast paced demanding activity, strong mind and attentiveness, eye for detail and very customized service to each visit. Up to 50 of these deliveries were managed everyday. From 8 to 10 hours a day, which is extreme on summer time.
