

I have actually been driving 7.5 tonne vehicles since I passed my driving test aged 19, I have recently driven across Europe in my own 7.5 tonne mercedes atego towing a 23ft caravan

I passed my HGV class 1 literally just before COVID then the world stopped lol!

I spent the last 3 years traveling across Europe in my own rig, and I have just returned to the UK to begin my driving career.

My previous career was in local government as a professionally qualified youth worker BHhons YOUTH WORK so very used to admin, computer literate etc. I held responsible positions managing staff and significant resources and also driving

minibuses with young people long distances around the country. Whilst I realise this is not necessarily the traditional 'experience on the road driving class 1' I do believe that these skills can be transferable to the LGV industry as I am very used to communicating and behaving in a professional manner

Obviously I am brand new to driving class 1 & 2 HGV and I'm not going to try and dress that up however I have over 30 years experience in driving 7.5 tonne vehicles all over Europe.

I realise that whilst I do have plenty of experience of driving LGV's privately I don't have experience in the industry and as such would be happy to work on a probationary period for less money to prove my commitment and ability.

I really hope that you at least have a look at my application and give me a chance, I think you will be pleased if you do as I am certainly very hard working and committed to my work and very reliable.

I also speak Spanish having lived there for the past 3 years before returning to the UK which is why I'm looking for work right now.
