After time, work wore thin, so since then I have been doing ad hoc driving work and also ad hoc labouring work. At this time I am seeking full time reliable employment so I can continue to support myself and my family.

I started this job during the lockdown after being let go from 2 agency jobs beforehand due to coronavirus.

My duties were to assemble orders of materials to be sent out to sites for jobs that need installing.

The resin warehouse were a wholesale building supplies company who supplied materials for resin bound surfaces, including driveways, patio areas, pool areas and pathways. I was also required to frequently deliver materials in the company van to sites where jobs are being installed.

This company folded very quickly without prior warning and i was left without a job. I believe they had rebranded to try and escape enforcement agent action from outstanding debts under a different company name that traded from the same site, but this did not work as they continued to show up, and eventually the site was vacated.

My reason for leaving this job was due to the complete lack of income it provided and the company was poorly structured. Management was poor and often we would go weeks without earning anything due to jobs not being able to be completed due to matters out of our own hands, they were able to do this as we were made to register as self employed. I have a family to support and had to make a decision based on mine and my family's best interests, and due to working for Kelly's, I fell into great financial difficulty.
